

PROCEDURES FOR CAMPUS MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

Call Extension 6427, 5555, or 911

LSUA has established procedures to follow in the event of a campus medical emergency. *It is important that these procedures are followed*.

8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Call Extension **6427**, **5555**, or **911** during normal work hours to activate the Emergency Response Committee in the event of a medical emergency. Provide the nature of the emergency and the location.

A member(s) of the Emergency Response Committee along with the Campus Safety Officer will be contacted and will respond.

After 4:30 p.m.

Call University Police at **473-6427**, Extension **6427** from an on campus line. If you cannot reach them, dial **9** (for an off-campus line) and **911**. The 911 operator will contact University Police.
